

Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma Project 6102 B Photo Journal



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Introduction

The Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma entered into a government to government agreement with Federal Highway Administration in 2007. Under this agreement the Pawnee Nation has greater latitude in determining what project it wanted to pursue and when to pursue them. Pawnee Nation determined it would be in the best interest of the Pawnee Nation members to build a new entry into the Pawnee Nation Complex to assist with economic development growth and provide adequate access to the many different governmental entities (IHS and BIA) as well as the many different Pawnee Nation programs. The name of this project is 6102 and it consists of at least three phases, maybe four. Construction of Phase A (grade, drain, and bridge) started 7/20/2011 and was completed in March of 2012. Construction Phase B (final grade, sidewalks, curb gutter, and surface) started September 20, 2012 and is expected to be completed in December of 2012.

Route 6102 Phase A Project

Phase A consisted of Grade, Drain, and Bridge. The time line for Phase A is as follows: Advertise for bid 3/23/2011, pre bid conference 4/14/2011, contract awarded 5/25/2011, notice to proceed issued 7/13/2011, pre work conference 7/13/2011, time started 8/16/2011, time stopped 8/16/2011 by order of FWHA, time resumed 9/19/2011, time suspended (EPA Review) 9/29/2011, time resumed 10/26/2011, project substantially complete 5/15/2012, phase A final payment made 10/22/2012. Route 6102 Phase B Project

The time line for phase B is as follows: Advertised for bid 7/18/2012, pre bid Conference 7/26/2012, bid opening 8/2/2012, contracted awarded 8/13/2012 notice to proceed issued 9/7/2011, pre-construction conference 8/6/2012, began work 8/20/2012. The above picture shows Phase A completed bridge.
