

# Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma

Resolution #15-37  
May 13, 2015

## RESOLUTION

- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council is the Supreme governing body of the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the Pawnee Tribal Constitution, and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council met in a special session on Wednesday, May 13, 2015, Pawnee Nation Multi-Purpose Building, duly authorized, with a quorum present; and
- Whereas,** by Resolution #13-58 authorized a lease for the property **including** 823.56 acres in Section 22, 23, & 26 Section 26 T29N-RO2E in and around the vicinity of the former Indian Government School, "Chilocco," and Mark Liegerot's bid amount for \$21,600.00 rent annually to be paid to the BIA - Pawnee Agency; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Nation does hereby authorize the assignment of the Liegerot lease to Curtis Winney until the end of the five year period beginning January 1, 2014 and ending December 31, 2018.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Pawnee Business Council hereby approves the assignment of lease of said property lands totaling 823.56 acres for the rest of the period of five years for an amount of \$21,600.00 annually. The assignee, Curtis Winney, is responsible for completing all terms of Items A - J. Specified Practices and additional lease requirements on this lease beginning as of this date and ending December 31, 2018


## CERTIFICATION


