For example, if I ask, “*Is it hot (weather)?*” then it is possible to respond in the positive by saying “*Yes, it is hot (weather).*” Additionally, it is also possible to respond in the negative by saying “*No, it is **not** hot (weather).*”

NOTE: B1 is the positive response, while B2 is the negative response.
