For example, if I ask, “*Is it raining?*” then it is possible to respond in the positive by saying “*Yes, it is raining.*” Additionally, it is also possible to respond in the negative by saying “*No, it is **not** raining.*”

NOTE: B1 is the positive response, while B2 is the negative response.
