RESOLUTION

- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and
- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council met in special session on March 13, 2018, at the Pawnee Nation Resource Center, duly authorized, with a quorum present; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Nation's people are its most valuable resource for interpreting the unique story of the Pawnee Nation. The Pawnee culture, history and knowledge lives within all relatives that comprise the Pawnee Nation today; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Nation recognizes the importance of protecting, preserving and documenting its oral histories from the perspective of the Pawnee People so their voice can perpetuate and be heard by future generations; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Nation desires to submit a Phase III Grant Application to the Multicultural Initiative for Community Advancements' (MICA) Cultural Resource Fund for development of the **Suruksta'iwât** (Tell It!) Oral History Preservation Project.




CERTIFICATION
