RESOLUTION

- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council met in special session on February 1, 2020, at the Pawnee Nation Roam Chief Event Center, duly authorized, with a quorum present; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the Pawnee Nation to establish a Tribal Employment Rights Office (TERO) within the jurisdiction of the Pawnee Nation to enforce special employment rights on behalf of its members; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council has the power to appoint Commissioners to the Pawnee Tribal Employment Rights Commission when vacancies occur, or appointments expire; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council does hereby appoint **Jamie Nelson** to serve on the Pawnee Nation Tribal Employment Rights Commission beginning February 1, 2020 and whose term will expire December 31, 2023.




CERTIFICATION
